Glass lantern photographic slides of Louisiana and world architecture, and were used as a teaching collection in the Tulane School of Architecture. Slides were individually made or purchased by the school in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. With the development of modern 2" x 2" plastic slides, the lantern slides fell into disuse, and were eventually transferred to Howard-Tilton Library.
